

The Elize Hele Education Foundation

Grants are given to boys and girls resident with their parents or guardians for five years, within the boundaries of Plymouth City, or designated Parishes of Yealmpton, Brixton, Sparkwell, Plympton St. Maurice and Plymstock. Grants are to aid students who, in the opinion of the trustees, are in need of financial assistance. These grants are to assist towards the commencement at all levels of full-time Further and Higher Education.

The John Lanyon Foundation, which works alongside the Elize Hele Foundation also exists for this purpose - but it deals only with pupils in the County Borough of Plymouth.

The two foundations grant funding to students starting life at University, College of Further Education, or other educational establishments, including professional, or technical ones. Grants are not made for maintenance while at such establishments, but are made to enable the commencement, properly equipped, of courses at such places. These may include the provision of clothing, computers, tools, equipment and books at all levels of further education. Students who apply are normally aged between 16 to 23 years.

In the year ending 31st March 2011, grants have ranged from £410 to £175 with the average being £311 per student, per annum. Students can reapply for further funding each year of their course.

Normally no awards are made for post-graduate, second or higher qualifications, home or part-time studies, or to mature student. All awards are made entirely at the discretion of the Trustees.
