Aim

To work collaboratively to improve the access to and safety of Silverbridge Way at Yealmpton by extending the existing path from its exit on the A379 at Yealmpton to Ben's Farm Shop along the inside of the road hedge.

Tasks

- 1 To ensure that any required formal legal agreements are in place.
- 2 To draw up and agree costed plans and specification for the extension to the path
- 3 To ensure that all the required administration is completed e.g., planning application, health & safety, etc.
- 4 To meet all the legal requirements for the County Council, District Council and Parish Councils for the extension of the path.
- 5 To draw up a project plan with milestones and timescales.
- 6 To apply for and maximise funding from Devon County Council, South Hams District Council, and other local and national funders.
- 7 To work with the chosen contractor for the extension
- 8 To plan for the long-term maintenance of the extension as a part of Silverbridge Way

Representatives will report to the respective Parish Councils at their monthly meetings.
